2-23 AP EXAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION



Please read all of the information below concerning 2023 AP Testing.

Directions for Registration:

- All students must register for AP exams online. Siblings must register separately. Each student needs his/her own individual registration.
- The AP Exam registration is a two step- two website- process again this year.
- **STEP 1:** Students should have already enrolled into their AP course on the College Board (CB) website, using a join code provided by the teacher. If a student needs a join code, please contact your AP Teacher ASAP. Students MUST keep up with their CB account login information. We do not have access to student accounts and students will need it to access it continually throughout the year to complete assignments and access their AP scores. If students need login assistance they must call 886-315-6068.
 - Students MUST indicate in each AP course on the College Board website whether they will take the exam in May or not. Exams will only be ordered for students who select "yes" to the "Order Exam?" question in each AP course on the College Board website. Students need to click the Yellow Box to indicate if they intend to take the exam.

- STEP 2: College Board does not collect exam payments; it only collects the exam order information from students. Therefore, students will also need to login to/create their Total Registration account to make payment.
 - Total Registration is used each year to pay for PSAT and AP exams. Students should use the same account and login information. If students already have a TR account, they should look for the "Have you previously registered? Login here." link.
 - If a student does not have a TR account, he/she must create an account. The account should use the student's email address not a parent's email address.

AP Exam Registration: GAVS or FVA, Independent Study (South Forsyth High School Students ONLY)

After reading through the process outlined above follow these steps:

- You will register for CB resources with a "join code" from your FVA or GAVS teacher and select "no" for your intent to take the exam (if applicable).
- You will register to pay for the AP exam through the SFHS Total Registration Website.
- You will receive an additional join code from SFHS during the TR registration process. This "Independent Study" join code allows you to register for an "Exam Only" section in the College Board MyAP platform, where you will select "yes" if you wish to take the exam.

I am planning on taking a spring semester GAVS AP Course and exam in May. When do I register?

- You will have a short spring semester window, starting in January, to register for spring GAVS AP Course exams.
- You will register for CB resources with a join code from your GAVS teacher and select "no" for your intent to take the exam (if applicable).
- You will register to pay for the AP exam through our SFHS Total Registration website.
- You will need to request an additional "Exam Only" join code from your AP Coordinator. This join code will link your exam order to SFHS.

Registration Deadline:

- Registration for all exams is currently underway and will conclude on Tuesday, October 25th.
- For courses that begin in January, exam registration and ordering will end on February 28th.
- Email Nicole Espy at nespy@forsyth.k12.ga.us ASAP to discuss the registration process. Late exam ordering fees will apply.

Cost for taking AP exams:

- For 2023 Testing, the College Board charges \$97.00 for each exam. In addition, students will pay a one-time administrative fee each year to offset the cost of testing materials, substitutes, etc. All high schools in Forsyth County charge a one-time fee of 25.00 regardless of how many exams a student takes.
- The cost for exams will be as follows:
 - 1 exam = \$122.00 (includes the exam fee of \$97.00 plus a <u>one-time</u> administrative fee of \$25.00)
 - 2 exams = \$219.00
 - 3 exams = \$316.00
 - 4 exams = \$413.00
 - 5 exams = \$510.00

Does the State of Georgia pay for one STEM exam per student?

- Students <u>enrolled</u> in STEM classes will be allowed to take their <u>first</u> AP STEM exam at a reduced cost. STEM students will only pay the administration fee of \$25.00. Approval for any registration with a STEM exam will be required; therefore, STEM students <u>cannot</u> pay for exams at the time of registration.
- You must indicate at the time of test registration that you are taking a STEM exam to receive the 97.00 credit.
- When STEM students register on Total Registration, they will be asked if they are taking at least one STEM exam. This is called a "special waiver."
 - Once a student has indicated s/he is taking a STEM exam, the registration is paused so that the school can verify this information. Once the fee waiver is verified, TR does NOT notify the student that they may now proceed with registration and make payment. <u>Students need to go back into their TR accounts within 48 hours of initial registration to check on the status of their registration and make payment.</u>

Is there a reduced cost for students with financial difficulty?

- Students who have applied and met Federal Free/Reduced Lunch criteria will receive up to two exams free of charge. They may receive additional exams at a reduced rate.
 - When they register for exams, students are asked if they meet Free/Reduced Lunch criteria. If the student indicates that they do meet Free/Reduced Lunch criteria, the registration process is paused until confirmation of this information.
