General Directions for the Two-Step Process

STEP 1: Access My AP Classroom at https://myap.collegeboard.org/login.

- Students should log in to the My AP platform if they already have an account or create one if this is their first time registering for an AP Course, SAT, or PSAT exam.
- Using the unique join code provided by the instructor for the specific course and section, students can register for their exams and gain access to AP course materials.
- Join codes given by teachers are tailored to each course, teacher, and class period.
- Students can also locate their join codes on the Total Registration Home Page under Account Functions, by selecting Student Account History (you may find the codes after completing STEP 2 below)
- Students MUST indicate in each AP course on the College Board website if they will take the exam in Mav.
- By default, each account is set to "Undecided," so students must choose either "yes" or "no" regarding their intention to take the AP exam before the October 22nd deadline.

Students must remember to keep track of their College Board account login details as AAI does not have access to student accounts.

STEP 2 Total Registration (TR): <u>http://www.totalregistration.net/AP/110088</u>

The College Board platform focuses on gathering exam order details from students and does not handle payments. Parents/guardians should work with their child to set up a Total Registration account, choose the AP Exams scheduled for May, and have finalize the exam payments.

- Students should use the same account and login credentials they used last year
 - Existing TR account holders can find the "Do you have an existing Total Registration account?" Login Here" link at the bottom of the page.
 - New students should create a TR account, which will be used in subsequent years.
 - How To Register for Payment Using Total Registration
 - Ensure that your student's personal information and email match the details in your My AP College Board account, not a parent's email.

- Once inside the TR system, students can proceed to select the exams they wish to take in the current academic year.
- If you are taking an **online AP course** look for the "Independent Study" (this is the Exam Only section) under teacher.

Exams are only ordered for students who complete ALL registration steps in My AP, Total Registration, and pay all exam fees by the deadline.

- Orders after October 22, 2024 @ 6PM, will have a \$40/exam late fee.
- Cancellations after November 15, 2024 @ 6PM, incur a \$40/exam fee.
- \$25 Admin fees are non-refundable.

Online Students will need to USE 2 Join Codes

- 1. The first join code will come from the online teacher for FVA or GAVS to access resources.
 - THIS DOES NOT ORDER YOUR AP EXAM!
- 2. You will need a second **"Exam Only"** join code to register for the Alliance AP Exams for your online course.
 - Register in Total Registration
 - If you are taking an online AP course look for the "Independent Study" under teacher
 - You will then find the second join code in Total Registration on the Home page under
 - Account Functions --> Student Account History after you register in Total Reg.

Detailed Instructions for AP Exam Registration for Online Courses

Key Dates

Registration Opens: Tuesday, September 3, 2024

Deadline: October 22, 2024, at 6:00 PM

Late Registration: October 23, 2024 to March 1, 2025 (Late fee: \$40/exam)

- Exams ordered after October 22, 2024 @ 6:00 PM, will incur a \$40/exam late fee from the College Board.
 - Late registration is between October 23, 2024 to March 1st 2025.
 - No exams will be ordered/ cancelled after March 1, 2025
 - Exam Cancellation
 - Must request cancellation through Total Registration
 - Full refund of exam fees if before November 15th, 2024 @ 6:00 PM
 - After November 15th, 2024 \$40/exam cancellation fee
 - \$25 Administrative fee is non-refundable

Cost for taking AP exams:

- For 2025 Testing, the College Board charges \$99.00 for each exam.
- \$147 for AP Seminar and AP Research
- In addition, students will pay a one-time administrative fee each year to offset the cost of testing materials, substitutes, etc. All high schools in Forsyth County charge a **one-time fee of \$25.00 each year** regardless of how many exams a student takes.

The cost/ for exams will be as follows:

- 1 exam = \$124.00 (includes the exam fee of \$99.00 plus a one-time administrative fee of \$25.00)
- 2 exams = \$223.00
- 3 exams = \$322.00
- 4 exams = \$421.00
- 5 exams = \$520.00

Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a late registration period and how much is the late fee?

- Students registering for exams in courses that begin in August will be assessed a \$40/ exam late registration fee after October 22nd.
- The \$40/exam late fee is charged by the College Board and cannot be canceled by the school. The school does not charge additional fees for registering between October 22nd February 28th.
 - If a student does not complete payment for all their exams by the October 22nd deadline, their exam status will be reset to "No." To reinstate these exams, the student will be assessed the \$40/exam late fee for all exams and they must complete payment, including late fees, before their exams will be ordered.

Can I cancel my exam?

- Regular registration students can cancel exams until November 15, 2024 with no charge.
- If regular registration students cancel exams after November 15, 2024, you will not be refunded your entire payment. College Board will only refund \$57 per test after November 15, 2024.
- If you cancel after November 15th, you will receive a partial refund minus the \$40/exam cancellation fee. The \$25.00 administrative fee is non-refundable after November 15, 2024 for yearlong AP courses and after February 28, 2025 for Spring semester-only AP courses.

Does the State of Georgia pay for one STEM exam per student?

- Students enrolled in STEM classes will be allowed to take their first AP STEM exam at a reduced cost. STEM students will only pay the administration fee of \$25.00. Approval for any registration with a STEM exam will be required; therefore, STEM students cannot pay for exams at the time of registration.
- You must indicate at the time of test registration that you are taking a STEM exam to receive the \$99.00 credit.

How/when is the state STEM Waiver applied?

When STEM students register on Total Registration, they will be asked if they are taking at least one STEM exam. This is called a "special waiver."

- Once a student has indicated s/he is taking a STEM exam, the registration is paused so that the school can verify this information.
- Once the fee waiver is verified, TR does NOT notify the student that they may now proceed with registration and make payment.
 - Students need to go back into their TR accounts within 24-48 hours of initial registration to check on the status of their registration and make payment.
 - Waivers are typically processed multiple times on school business days

Is there a reduced cost for students with financial difficulty?

- Students who have applied and met Federal Free/Reduced Lunch criteria will receive a maximum of two exams free of charge. They may receive additional exams at a reduced rate.
- When registering for exams, students are asked if they meet Free/Reduced Lunch criteria. If the student indicates that they do meet Free/Reduced Lunch criteria, the registration process is paused until confirmation of this information.
