WHY DO COLLEGES LIKE ADVANCED PLACEMENT?

- Rigorous common curriculum throughout the nation/world equivalent to introductory college-level classes.
- Standardized assessments at the end of the course, measuring student mastery of college-level work.
- Continuing education, professional development institutes and seminars for teachers.

WHAT IS ADVANCED PLACEMENT?

- AP[®] courses are college-level courses offered in the supportive high school environment.
- A score of 3 or higher on an AP exam can typically earn students college credit and/or placement into advanced courses in college.

WHY TAKE AN AP COURSE?


- To explore more in-depth subjects and topics that interest you compared to traditional classes.


