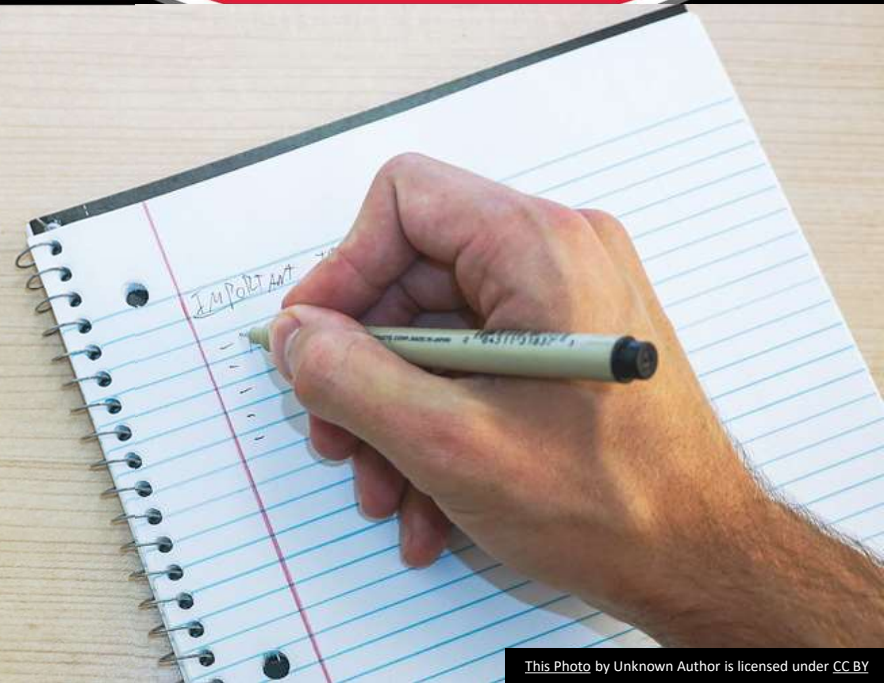

- Advanced Composition, AP Lit, or Dramatic Writing



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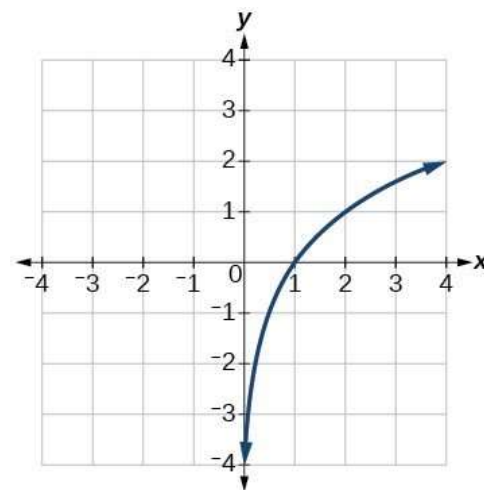


# Math Credits

# GPA

- **Forsyth Central GPA:**
- All Classes taken 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> are factored into GPA
- AP/Dual Enrollment full quality point given
- Pay attention to the credit awarded for the class
  - 1.0 yearlong courses
  - .5 semester long courses

- A=5.0
- B=4.0

# GPA continued...



## HOPE/Zell Miller GPA

- Only core classes taken 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> are included in the GPA
  - Math, Science, Language Arts, Social Science, World Language, most AP courses
- AP/Dual Enrollment courses awarded .5 quality point with nothing above a 4.0
- Pay attention to the credit awarded for the class
  - 1.0 yearlong courses
  - .5 semester long courses
