

We strongly encourage you to utilize the information provided to make an informed decision regarding your final elective choices. *The Portal will OPEN on March 4th at 8:00am. The Portal will CLOSE on March 11th at 4:00pm.

HELPFUL REMINDERS:

*Students/Parents should select the number of elective courses to equal seven (7) classes and three (3) alternate classes. In parent portal you will see 70/70 if you have a complete schedule. If a course ends with a "y", this is a year-long course and counts as one class. If a course ends with a "s", this is a semester course, requiring you to select two courses to equal the full credit. (e.g. 603225s Drivers Education & 601655s Intro to Team Sports). Your schedule will be incomplete if you do not select two "s" classes.

*If there is no course number but a teacher name, this course requires an application. Please contact that teacher directly and/or visit the FCHS website for the application.

*Parents must complete an on-line course waiver form if they disagree and wish to change a teacher's core course recommendation. The waiver is accessible via the FCHS website under the Registration Link. All waivers must be submitted no later than March 23rd at 4:00pm.
