SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

Goal 1: By the end of the 2021-2022 school year, the percentage of K-5 students reading at the proficient or above level will increase from 79% in May 2021 to 86% in May of 2022 as determined by the IRLA (Independent Reading Level Assessment) Framework.

Goal 2: During the 2021-22 school year, Midway will implement strategies in an effort to improve school climate and culture for all stakeholders. We seek to measure this improvement by increasing the average on our Ridiculously Amazing Schools Climate Survey score from 11.126 to 15.

In the context of the Ridiculously Amazing Schools Climate Survey, we define school climate and culture as a variable sum score of 9 Likert-type measures (Strongly disagree = -2, Disagree = -1, Agree = 1, Strongly agree = 2) with possible range from -18 to 18.
