Please read the important information below before enrolling in activities.

Make sure your activities do not conflict with other after-school commitments for your child(ren) such as chorus, sports, Instructional Extension, etc. **and** you have signed up for only **one activity per day** . *Refunds will not be issued after Session 4 begins on 3/24/25.*

Students in Instructional Extension will be required to attend their IE session on activity meeting dates. IE Math students will miss Monday Activity dates of 3/24 and 4/7. IE Reading students will miss Wednesday Activity dates of 3/26 and 4/9.

All dates for session 4 are listed below. Refunds and pro-rated fees are **not** offered for students participating in both competition and 5-week activities.
