

- SAT: 480 Evidence Based Reading & Writing|440 Math|1200 Total OR
- ACT: 17 English or Reading|17 Math|26
 Composite

Steps to Apply

- 1. Submit KSU Dual Enrollment application at dep.kennesaw.edu.
- 2. Submit official high school transcript and any previous college credit.
- 3. Submit official test scores if applicable.
- 4. Submit KSU New Student Form.

11th and 12th Grade Requirements

- Successful Completion of 10th Grade
 - 3.0 (+) KSU Recalculated GPA
- PSAT/SAT: 480 Evidence Based Reading & Writing|440 Math
 OR
- PreACT/ACT: 17 English or Reading|17 MathOR
- Accuplacer: 237 Reading|4 WritePlacer|258
 Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra & Statistics
 - 3.2 (+) Test Optional Admittance





 Acceptable test formats: SAT, ACT, Accuplacer, pSAT, PreACT.
- 4 Submit proof of lawful presence

- Complete funding application

 GA Futures funding application is required as a separate process to obtain funding for DE courses.
