\*\*\*Beginning Summer 2025, ECON 1101 is the only Dual Enrollment class that satisfies HS graduation requirement. ECON 2105/2106 will count as electives.

\*\*\*\*Earning World Language credit is not a high school graduation requirement. However, most all 4-year colleges/universities do require students to have taken, at minimum, 2 levels of the same World Language (ex: Spanish I and Spanish II). Best practice is to check with the schools you plan on applying to!

- If you want to be eligible for HOPE or Zell Miller Scholarship, one of the requirements is that you need to have taken [4 HOPE Rigor courses](#) by graduation.
- EOC courses: Algebra: Concepts & Connections, Lit & Comp II, Biology, and US History (exempt from EOC if taking AP/IB/DE US History)
