Beginning Summer 2025, ECON 1101 is the only Dual Enrollment class that satisfies HS graduation requirement. ECON 2105/2106 will count as electives. *Earning World Language credit is not a high school graduation requirement. However, most all 4-year colleges/universities do require students to have taken, at minimum, 2 levels of the same World Language (ex: Spanish I and Spanish II).
