#1. Social & Emotional Health	All teachers conducted morning meetings during the 22-23 school year and our counselors provided support to teachers new to class meetings. The counselors conducted a weekly Mindfulness segment on our school news and students assisted in leading the news segment periodically. As we continue to focus on class meetings and connecting with students we will add a morning greeting to our strategies and wi continue with our weekly Mindfulness segment on the news. Additionally, we will send staff members to Mindfulness training throughout the 23-24 school year. Big Creek administrative team provided monthly surprise and delights to staff members; this was very well received, and this will continue in the 23-24 school year.	
#4 Climate, Culture, & Community	Our Denmark Community of Schools Spring Fling was well attended and met our goal of connecting with students across our vertical team. The elementary chorus groups performed together, the middle school chorus performed, and the high school drum line performed. Each school's PTO set up booths with carnival style games, we had a DJ, food trucks, public library on wheels, and jump houses. Big Creek passed out Denmark Community of Schools drawstring bags to students in August in order to foster a community feeling. We plan to continue with our Spring Fling next year.	
#5 The Learner Experience	Professional learning communities were implemented on a weekly basis and supported by our instructional coaches, educational technology coach and assistant principal assigned to the grade level. Our PLC's are instrumental in leveraging high level instructional strategies and meeting the needs of all students. Participating in the pilot was a tremendous asset as our teachers had the opportunity to work with our Teaching and Learning content specialists on a consistent basis. We have established a structure for weekly PLC meetings and we will continue to grow in this area and adapt as needed. We discussed PLC growth at our leadership team meeting in June and will further our knowledge through the PLL meetings each month. We are very pleased with the impact of our PLC process and look forward to continued growth and learning. The goal of our PLC is to have a positive impact on student growth.	
#5 The Learner Experience	Each grade level participated in monthly MTSS meetings and implemented kid talks. Teachers analyzed data and provided high level strategies to students during the MTSS block in order to remediate or enrich students based on individual need.
