World Languages

AP Spanish Language and Culture – is the equivalent of an upper-intermediate college course in Spanish. It provides advanced language students with a rich and rigorous opportunity to study the language and culture of the Spanish-speaking world. It promotes fluency and accuracy in language use and an exploration of culture in both contemporary and historical contexts. The course is taught in the target language. **Requirements:** Successful completion of Spanish 4 or Native Speakers 2. Open to students in10-12th grades.

AP French Language and Culture — is the equivalent of an upper-intermediate college course in French. It provides advanced language students with a rich and rigorous opportunity to study the language and culture of the French-speaking world. It promotes fluency and accuracy in language use and an exploration of culture in both contemporary and historical contexts. The course is taught in the target language. **Requirements:** Successful completion of French 3. **Recommended:** Successful completion of French 4.Open to students in 10th and 11th grade who have completed the recommended courses or 12th grade who have completed the required courses.

AP German Language and Culture – is the equivalent of an upper-intermediate college course in German. It provides advanced language students with a rich and rigorous opportunity to study the language and culture of the German-speaking world. It promotes fluency and accuracy in language use and an exploration of culture in both contemporary and historical contexts. The course is taught in the target language. **Requirements:** Successful completion of German 3. **Recommended:** Successful completion of German 4.Open to students in 10th and 11th grade who have completed the recommended courses or 12th grade who have completed the required courses.

AP Spanish Literature and Culture – is the equivalent of an introductory junior level college course in Spanish Literature. It introduces students to the formal study of a representative body of texts from Peninsular Spanish, Latin American and U.S. Hispanic literature. **Requirements:** Completion of AP Spanish Language or IB Spanish SL/HL. Open to students in 12th grade.

AP Latin — is the equivalent of an upper-intermediate college course and provides students with a rich and rigorous opportunity to study Latin. AP Latin students develop their language skills through precise, literal translation of prepared poetry and prose; read and comprehend sight passages, both poetry and prose; and write analyses that demonstrate the results of critical reading in clear and coherent arguments supported by textual examples. Students will also learn about the history, literature and culture of the ancient Romans. **Requirements:** Successful completion of Latin 3. Open to students in 12th grade.
