Dear Students and Parents,

Welcome back! We had a great year in band last year, and we know this year will be our best yet!

Please take a moment to review the Riverwatch Band Handbook and calendar posted on the band section of the RMS website (go to the "Academics" tab and click on "Connections"). The calendar is also copied on the back of this letter for your convenience. **Then,** please complete and turn in the bottom of this form by **Friday, August 16**<sup>th</sup> to acknowledge that you have read the RMS Band Handbook and agree to abide by the policies set forth therein:

Every student in the band needs a black RMS band polo shirt. These will be worn for the "Grade Level Concerts" in the Fall and Spring. If you do not have the band polo, or if you would like to purchase a new shirt, please log on the MyPaymentsPlus to contribute \$20.00 to cover the cost. If your band polo still fits from last year and is in good condition for concerts, there is no contribution needed.

Students in the Symphonic Band will also be provided with the **Symphonic Band Uniform** – a black dress shirt and black clip-on tie. They will need to provide their own **black dress pants**, **black belt**, **long black socks**, **and black dress shoes**. They will wear this uniform for **Symphonic Band ONLY performances**.

We will be communicating with parents throughout the year using email addresses listed in Parent Portal. Please make sure your email address is up-to-date on Parent Portal so that you will receive band emails.

We will hold **Symphonic Band** chair placement auditions at the end of August during class. This "chair list" will last throughout the entire fall semester. Students should be prepared to play the GMEA Middle School All-State 4 Major Scales & Chromatic Scale, as well as the Chair Placement Etude. Scales do not need to be memorized for this audition. Students may play additional major scales and extended ranges. Extra scales/range will only increase student's score if they are correct and with characteristic tone quality. Mistakes will not negatively affect students' scores, but scales should be learned if student plans to attempt them (no sight reading, please).
